All the Principals are requested to please ensure that all forms, fees and relevant documents are submitted to the University strictly adhering to the above programme and instructions mentioned below :

- Examinations fees along with the cost of examination forms @ Rs.10/- per candidate is to be deposited by the candidate. However a portion of centre fees may be retained by the concerned college as per university norms. No other deduction excepting the aforesaid portion of the centre fees should be made from the examination fees. A statement showing the details of fees and cost of application forms collected from the students along with deduction shall have to be submitted by the college at the time of submission of application forms to the University.
- Candidates of TDC/TDCH Part-II examinations 2010 (Under 1+1+1 System) having back paper(s) in Part-I examination will be required to submit separate prescribed application form for back paper(s) of Part-I exam and Part-II examination along with requisite fees.
- The college authority is requested to submit the fees in demand draft or by cheque on **State Bank of India in favour of Registrar, Tripura University** on or before the dates fixed by the University.
- Dates of submission of forms are to be maintained strictly.
- Filled in application forms are to be submitted to the University after proper scrutiny.
- No forms will be received beyond the stipulated dates.
- Admit Cards will be delivered only to persons authorized by the Principal of the concerned college.
- Forms of different categories are to be sent in separate packets to the University. These forms shall not be mixed up under any circumstances.
- The detailed programme of the examinations will be notified later on.
